

Easter Tournament Conditions

1. Entries to be made online via the MiTournament website or to the Tournament Secretary, The Flinders Golf Club, PO Box 11, Flinders 3929 and will only be accepted accompanied with entry fee and Golflink number. Entries may be attached in electronic form. A valid Golf Australia Handicap is required by for all entrants. Entries will not be accepted by telephone.
2. Entries for all events close with the Tournament Secretary on FRIDAY 12th APRIL 2019 at 5pm, or as soon as fields have reached capacity, late entries will be accepted if vacancies are present in the field.
3. Entries for Four Ball Events must be made in pairs. The full entry fee must accompany the form – i.e. for both partners and both Golflink numbers must be shown.
4. Requests for particular hit off times will receive sympathetic consideration but no guarantee can be given that such requests will be met.
5. Entries are restricted to Amateurs who are members of affiliated Clubs with or recognised by Golf Australia, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
6. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R & A, together with such local rules and conditions of competition, as are in force at The Flinders Golf Club. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Golf Committee of The Flinders Golf Club (hereinafter called the Golf Committee) whose decision shall be final.
7. The Golf Committee shall make all arrangements and have full power to alter the programme if necessary and make any variations in the conditions except paragraph 5. The Golf Committee reserves the right to make any alterations in the handicaps before an event is played if deemed desirable.
8. Entry into Events 4 – 7 shall be determined by G.A handicap of the day.
9. Competitors must be prepared to play when called upon by the Golf Committee and must be on the tee ten minutes before their starting time. All events will start at the 1st tee, unless otherwise determined by the Golf Committee.
10. The Starter is authorised to move players forward to fill any gaps due to late arrivals. Refusal to move up will result in that player or those being moved to the end of the field. Players arriving late on the tee will also be moved to the end of the field.
11. A tie in the championship events 4 and 6 shall be decided by a sudden death play-off over Holes 1, 2, 16, 17 and 18.
12. In the event of a tie in any other event, a countback will be decided in accordance with the FGC standard Conditions of Competition. Details of the system are posted in the Clubhouse.
13. No refunds will be given for cancellations or for play cancelled as a result of weather conditions.
14. The personal details requested from players are for the purpose of: Registering players into a golf tournament as described on this form / listing player's names into a tournament field and publishing that field on the Club's website / Recording details on the Club's database for the purpose of mailing future tournament entry forms and information.
15. The hole in one prize will be awarded to the first person who holes out on the 12th hole during the three days of the tournament. The 17th hole will be in play on Saturday only for the Men as they will not be hitting off on the 12th.
