**MOUNT MARTHA GOLF CLUB**  
**CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

- 1. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry. Closing date 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2019**
2. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrew's Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course on which the competition takes place
- 3. The event is open to Amateurs only who are members of a GA affiliated Golf Club**
4. The Match Committee has the power to alter or make any variations in the conditions should they deem it necessary. The Match Committee will be the final arbiter, in case of dispute or protest.
- 5. The Match Committee or such person as the Match Committee may authorise, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, either shorten the event or arrange another day.**
6. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined by a count back as per Golf Australia Rules.
- 7. Mobile phones may be carried for emergencies, but switched off or on silent during play.**
8. The Match Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries which will be received in the event and to alter the time fixed for starting the event as indicated in this program.
9. The scorecard must be signed by one of the team players and a marker from the opposing team prior to submission. **Failure to do so will result in disqualification.**
