#### BUNINYONG GOLF CLUB WOMEN'S GOLDEN JUBILEE SALVER – CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. The entry fee and cart hire (if required) is to be paid at time of entry. A refund will not be paid unless withdrawal is completed seven working days prior to the event.
- 2. The event is open to female amateur golfers who are members of a golf club affiliated with Golf Australia and/or who have an official handicap. The BGC Match Committee shall have the right to refuse any entry of any person without being required to provide a reason.
- 3. This event includes both individual and team competitions.

  Ballarat District participants (except BGC members) are eligible for BDG Merit Award points.
- 4. To be eligible to be awarded the Salver, all three team members must be members of the same golf club.
- 5. The event will be played in accordance with the R&A Rules of Golf together with such local rules in force on the day of play. If a dispute arises it shall be addressed by the Match Committee whose decision will be final.
- 6. The Match Committee shall make arrangements for the event and may if need arises, vary arrangements and/or conditions. For example, in the event of extreme weather or for any other reason, the event may be shortened or cancelled, or postponed.
  - a. In the event of lightning and or an electrical storm a siren will deliver one prolonged continuous burst of sound, indicating golfers are to leave the course immediately after marking ball place and are not to complete the hole. If play is to resume the siren will sound two short bursts, repeated, indicating a return to the course.
- 7. In the event of a tie/s place getters will be decided by a Golf Australia count back system.
- 8. Mobile phones may be carried on the course but must be turned off or silent and used only to contact the Club House or in an emergency.
- 9. Pace of play: Players are encouraged to adhere to pace of play rules (Rule 6.7).
- 10. During the event players may have the opportunity to have their photograph taken to highlight the event on BGC website or promote women's golf. Any player not wishing to have their photograph taken or published merely needs to decline the offer at the time or inform BGC that the do not with their image and details to be published.
- 11. Motorised carts are permitted.
