

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR 4BBB COMPETITION.

1. All financial playing members of clubs with officially recognised Handicaps are eligible to compete in competitions according to individual entry form requirements. It is each player's responsibility to ascertain her correct handicap. Certification of an Australian Handicap must be produced on request.
2. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R & A and USGA, subject to such local rules as are in force on the course on which the competition takes place.
3. The Match Committee makes all arrangements and has full power to alter or make any variations to the conditions should they deem it desirable and shall have the right to refuse entry to any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
4. Any dispute or protests will be decided by the Match Committee whose decision is final.
5. The Match Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Preference may be given according to specific conditions on individual entry forms.
6. Competitors must be ready to start at appointed time. If players arrive after their starting time Rule 5-3 applies. If only one player is at the starting point then they may play on their own. Their partner may join them anytime but not during the play of the hole. Also read Rule 5-3a
7. For all events players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance. A multi functional device such as a smart phone may also be used as a distance measuring device but it may not be used to gauge or measure other conditions as stated below - a breach of Rule 4-3 If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 4-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is used.
8. All competitors are required to comply with the dress regulations of the club.
9. Pace of Play: If a player fails to keep her place in the field and is not adhering to the required pace of play she may be penalised in accordance with Rule 5.6.
