

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry. No entry fees will be refunded to a competitor/s withdrawing after the closing date unless Management approves special circumstances.
2. The event is open to amateur golfers who are Members of affiliated Golf Clubs and who hold a current Golf Australia handicap. The Management of Settlers Run Golf & Country Club shall have the right to refuse entry of any person(s) without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
3. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by The Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with any local rules which are in force on the course. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Club Professional.
4. Settlers Run Golf and Country Club will make all arrangements, and have full power to alter or make variations to the conditions should they deem it necessary or desirable.
5. Ties for trophy winners will be decided on the count back procedure as recommended by Golf Australia.

How to play 4 Persons Modified Ambrose – also called Gentsomes

Each player plays a tee shot.

- Choose the "preferred" ball, which must be played from where it comes to rest. Ball must be marked if played first.
- Other players, in any order, **DROP** their ball within one club length of the "preferred" ball, not nearer the hole.
- If the "preferred" ball lands on the green, players must **PLACE** their ball as close to the spot as possible.
- If the "Preferred" ball is in the rough or a hazard, the other players must **DROP** their ball in the rough or hazard, within one club length of the "preferred" ball.
- For all subsequent shots. players play their own ball, where it lies until holed out (or picked up if two better or equal Stableford scores are known).
- Record the two higher Stableford scores on each hole and record the player whose tee shot was selected.
- A hole-in-one can be the preferred ball, provided the player has not reached the maximum number of tee shots. If used the two higher Stableford scores, using the hole-in-one as each player's shot, are recorded
- All players are eligible for NTP & Hole-in-One privileges, regardless of Tee shot restrictions.
