2020 LADIES CLASSIC - CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1) Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R & A Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland and the Local Rules of the Club.
- 2) All events are open to Amateurs who are members of a registered club. The Board shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to give any reason for refusal.
- 3) If a dispute arises it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee. Any protest must be lodged with the Tournament Committee prior to the posting of cards.
- 4) Golf Australia Handicaps only to be used and players must be able to provide proof. Handicaps will not be altered during the two days of the tournament and a player's handicap on the first day of play will apply for both days.
- 5) In the event of a tie, Golf Australia's count back system will be used.
- 6) Mobile Phones must be switched off whilst on the course and in the Clubhouse. Except for Rules or emergency assistance.
- 7) The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play if deemed necessary and to limit the number of entries.
- 8) Measuring devices are permitted on the course subject to the Local Rules.
- 9) **Motorised golf carts are available for hire. Please book a golf cart online or via booking form.**
- 10) Heat Policy: In circumstances of extreme weather, events may be shortened or postponed at the direction of the Tournament Committee. When conditions become unexpectedly adverse during the course of an event, the Tournament Committee may suspend play. If play is suspended a 15 second blast of the siren will be sounded. Players MUST mark their ball and return to the safety of the Clubhouse.
- 11) Slow Play – Rule 6-7. We have a large field so please keep up with the group in front. There are penalties for slow play and there will be a Marshall monitoring play. If you lose a ball and the group behind is waiting please call them through.
- 12) Entry fees will not be refunded after the draw has been completed.
- 13) Dress Code: Neat golf attire and soft spikes
