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Conditions for Competition

1. Entry is open to teams of three (3) armature women members of clubs affiliated with Golf Australia with individual GA Handicap limit of 39.7 at time of entry.
2. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry and will be accepted in order of receipt, until the field has reached capacity or by 10th February 2020.
3. Eligible substitutes will be accepted.
4. The competition shall be played according to Golf Australia.
If a dispute arises on any point it shall be decided by the Ladies Match Committee of Centenary Park Golf Club whose decision shall be final.
5. The Match Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries per club.
6. The Match Committee, or such person as the Match Committee may authorise, may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest, or set another day.
7. Competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Match Committee may arrange.
8. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined by a count back, including all team members as per Golf Australia's Guidelines.
9. There will be no refund on payment of entry fee.
